- Gal 1:3 - Grace <charis> charity, charismatic, gratis, gratuity – Greek greeting
Peace (eirene, from Hebrew shalom) Hebrew greeting.
- Gal 1:4,5 - Age <aioon> Luke 1:70, Hebr 1:2
- Gal 1:6 - Gospel <eu-angelion> cf angel <angelos> (vs 8) Preach <eu-angelizetai> (vs 8) cf Luk 7:24, Rev 2:1. Hebr. 'malak'.
- Gal 1:6 - By the grace of Christ <en chariti Christou>
- Gal 1:6,7 - Different <heteros> different of another kind
Another <allos> another of the same kind. See NKJV
- Gal 1:7 - Pervert <metastrephai> cf Acts 2:20 – total change / desertion / change a treaty
- Gal 1:8,9 - Eternally condemned <anathema> In Septuagint translation of Hebr. Kherem - taboo
- Gal 1:10 - Servant <doulos>
- Gal 1:12 - Revelation <apokalypsis>
